The Midland Public Library Board promotes and expects the Midland Public Library to be a safe working environment for all staff and a welcoming place for business and leisure activities for Midland and its surrounding communities.

The Library asks for your cooperation in maintaining a welcoming environment conducive to study and enjoyable use of the Library. Staff make every effort to apply these rules in a fair, dignified and positive manner for the benefit of all. Any behaviour that does not support a safe and welcoming environment may result in cost-recovery charges, suspension of library privileges, expulsion from the Library and its premises on the basis of the Ontario *Trespass to Property Act* and/or prosecution. The library staff reserve the right to inspect the contents of all bags, purses, backpacks and personal property while on library premises.

The following behaviors are not allowed and will not be tolerated at any time inside the Library or on the exterior premises:

1. Violent, threatening, abusive, discriminatory, derogatory or harassing language or conduct of any kind.
2. Disruptive or intrusive behaviour.
3. Sleeping on library premises.
4. Loitering.
5. Illegal activities including, but not limited to, the use or sale of drugs.
6. Smoking, vaping or use of other tobacco or cannabis products inside library facilities and/or within 9 meters/30 feet of any entrance.
7. Unauthorized consumption of alcoholic beverages, or bringing alcohol onto library premises.
8. Carrying a weapon of any type.
9. Be in a state of intoxication that causes public disturbance or safety concerns.
10. Damage, misuse, or theft of library materials, equipment and property.

11. Interfering with the designated use of computers and networks.
12. Engaging in any sexual contact or lewd behaviour on library property.
13. Use of MPL restrooms for bathing, shaving, washing hair, etc.
14. Entering the library facility without being fully clothed, including bare feet.
15. Unhygienic behaviour such as spitting, clipping nails, etc.
16. Maintaining a level of hygiene that interferes with the use of the library by other patrons.
17. Leaving personal property unattended inside the Library or on the exterior Library grounds.
18. Destructive behaviour of any kind, causing, or that has potential to cause, damage to the Library property.
